Did you know...

- The garbage in the Tuscarora Landfill produces about 12,000 gallons of leachate per day
- On average, the Tuscarora Landfill receives 725 tons of solid waster per day.
- According to the EPA, the average American person will produce about 5.91 pounds of trash, with about 1.51 pounds being recycled; 4.40 pounds is the rough average daily waste per person.

Resolution Honoring David Warmack

WHEREAS, David Warmack began his service with the Coastal Regional Solid Waste Management Authority (CRSWMA) on July 25, 1994, and will retire on June 30, 2021, and

WHEREAS, David rapidly advanced through several promotions, ultimately becoming Operations Manager in 1998 and remaining in that position for 23 years, and

WHEREAS, David was instrumental in the development and progression in the early years of CRSWMA, and

WHEREAS, during his tenure as Operations Manager, David has been involved in numerous initiatives of great importance to CRSWMA including multiple expansions and closures at the Tuscarora Landfill, development of a landfill-gas-to-energy system, and repayment of the original revenue bonds;

WHEREAS, David's development of operational practices and employee training will impact CRSWMA for several decades;

WHEREAS, CRSWMA wishes to recognize David for his dedication and excellent service to the citizens of Carteret, Craven, and Pamlico Counties, and express their appreciation for his work,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Coastal Regional Solid Waste Management Authority hereby honors David Warmack for his long and distinguished career, and for his commitment, dedication, and leadership to CRSWMA. CRSWMA expresses its appreciation for his service, and wishes him well during retirement.

Boats That Don't Float and More

So you have a boat that won't float. What do you do with it? Well, you can take it to the Tuscarora Landfill. Simply pull up on the scales, let us get a weight, take it to the dumping site, drop it off, go back to the scales, let us get an empty weight, pay and exit. The charge is \$40 per ton, the same as solid waste. If you want to dispose of your motor, please make sure it free of fluids as they are banned from landfills. We also take trailers, campers, RV's, jet skis and motorcycles.



As an alternative, Carteret Community College has a program that will assist you getting rid of aquatic vehicles. They accept donations of boats, jet skis, yachts, cars, RVs, trailers, motorcycle, vans, boat motors, boating equipment, fishing gear, kayaks and much more.
